SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

- Continued effort for Free and Reduced Lunch applications for students and families. Attempts to increase awareness through mailings, online registration, Facebook, contact at start of school and information from our feeder schools.
- Met with Karri Hammerstrom, Regional Chair of Central/Mother Lode Regional Consortium who works with community colleges and Career Technical Education. A great source of knowledge on the programs and state funding earmarked for CTE "Work Force Program".
- Maintenance building is on schedule to be complete September 2018.

PRINCIPAL REPORT

- Second semester of summer school started with 337 students and finished with 316, better than
 the first half of summer school.
- Master Schedule, that will be approved tonight, is built with great detail to student needs, staff
 needs, budget and class variables. Mrs. Pavlina works hard to develop Kingsburg High School's
 master schedule, that produces 94% accuracy outcome rate.
- Very excited for the upcoming new year! KHS has some great new teacher hires that will add top notch quality and energy to our school.
- The KHS Family will make new hires feel welcome. Administration touches base with new hires on a regular basis as they prepare for the start of the school year. At the first in-service day, polo shirts will be presented to the new hires.

AMBASSADORS OF COMPASSIONS PRESENTATION

- Grant Thiessen, Presenter
- Ambassadors of Compassion program objective is to bring together the wisdom and expertise of leaders to help youth with resiliency, compassion and personal skills in order to be successful in life. Encompasses a twelve week program and community service project.
- Materials were presented to the Board to show what is used during the AOC Program.
- Example of Lesson Plan "Influences" Students receive lesson, journal action plans made regarding the lesson, with final follow up to stress accountability of their personal goals and outcomes.
- Program benefits the growth of participating students as well as the leaders.
- Within the Kingsburg community, more than 800 students have participated in the AOC program, (Kingsburg Charter Elementary School District, OASIS and Kingsburg High School)
- Program is open to all students, with a focus at this time on Sports Teams at the Kingsburg High School.
- Some students also participate one hour a week during their P.E. classes. Board stressed that the program is best offered outside of class time.
- AOC Leaders are trained by an online program. Board acknowledged that this is a good
 procedure, and stressed the continued supervision of the leaders who are directing the student
 AOC program.
