Maintenance Building: Final costs to the project. Listed on the expenditure report.

<u>Solar Buyout</u>: The solar buy-out is on hold until the next buyout negotiations in 2022. Silicon Ranch was very difficult to deal with and extremely slow in their responses. Silicon Ranch had the system appraised at 2.7 million however we only had 1.8 budgeted for this project.

Options were:

- 1. Pay 2.7 million. We had 1.8 million budgeted for the solar buyout.
- 2. Pay 1.6 million to break the contract and have Silicon Ranch come and get the panels. If they get the panels, a new replacement is estimated at 1 million.
- 3. Wait until the next window and negotiate again in 2022. The board of trustees, elected to take option #3 at this point.

Baseball field: Fields Irrigation

The baseball field is in its final phase of seeding Bermuda grass. There were no additional costs to the seeding of the field. The total cost of the field was \$120,880 with \$150,000 budgeted.

MIsc Flatwork, Fencing, and Landscaping

Several projects listed on expenditure report. Mostly upgrade landscape, removal of large trees, new concrete, fencing for gym storage area.

Oasis re-roofing

The roofs were recently fixed at our Oasis campus. All roofs were fixed on the campus with a 20-year warranty. Total costs were \$122,400. The original budget was \$100,000. The project was put out to bid with 5 companies bidding on the project with the lowest bidder awarded the job.

Campus Hardscape:

The flatwork project is moving through DSA and we are waiting for final approval to put the project out to bid. We are still on budget at 1.5 million for this project. Costs are from Architect and DSA fees.

Our goal is to replace, repair, and update the areas around the theater and adding walkways and landscaping around the music building and in front of the gym. We will also be adding a wall to create space teaching activities for our stage arts.

Ag Canopy

The canopy project is with the DSA for final approval. After DSA approval it will be sent out to bid. The original budget for this project was \$450,000, our estimates will be at \$150,000. Current costs are \$12,081 from architect and DSA fees.

Pool: (not in this year's expenditures)

The pool project was finished in partnership with the city. The final costs to the district were \$312,000 after all the change orders. We are very happy with this project and our partnership with the city even though this project was slightly over budget. The original budget was \$250,000. The lowest bid was \$600,000 of which we cover 50% with the city.
